

# Lunch Duty #2-Wipe Tables/Mop

## Lunch Duty #2 - 11:25-12:25

- Familiarize yourself with all the rules by reading all specific duties below and everything in the right hand column before you begin.
- You have the authority to remind anyone of co-op rules.
- Find the appropriate name tag in the **green notebook**. Please wear so others will know who is on duty.
- Eat before or after lunch duty.
- Lunch duty is not a time to visit with other moms.
- You and the morning hall monitor and the other lunch duty parents are responsible for all children during this time.
- Children must stay in the lunchroom the entire lunch hour for safety reasons. No exceptions (except restroom with permission).
- Children are not allowed in the art room/kitchen during lunch and may not use the microwave or refrigerator.
- No running is allowed inside.
- No balls or others toys are allowed.
- **Get mop bucket from supply closet (located to the right of the women's restroom). Partially fill with warm water from faucet in closet. No soap. Take mop bucket and mop to lunch room. This is to be used for spills only. We just need to damp mop so sticky spills don't spread around the whole gym. Once the tables are picked up, you'll be able to tell where to mop. You don't have to mop the whole area.**
- While children are eating, assist any younger children who need help.
- The whistle is blown at 12:00 by lunch duty parent #1 to signal clean up.
- **Make sure children clean up their own eating area when done. Children are dismissed table by table when they have cleaned up their trash.**
- All children, even older ones, not helping to clean up and not playing outside should move to the other side of the gym to facilitate clean up.
- Begin cleaning as soon as the tables get cleared off, so you will be finished by 12:20 class time.
- **Wipe down tables (cleaner and cloth towels are provided).**
- **Clean any spills on chairs using carpet cleaner and brush from supply closet.**
- **All tables and chairs need to be put away for afternoon PE classes. Children 7<sup>th</sup> and up should help with this.**
- Only Jacob Rohrer, Rob Adkins, and those assisting them are allowed to move stacked chairs and tables. Stacks could be dangerous if toppled over.
- **Mop the spills. Empty mop bucket outside and return mop and bucket to supply closet.**

## **All Duty Hours Please Follow:**

- It is best to find childcare for your younger children. If this is not possible, bring quiet activities to keep them busy.
- Make sure children are not roaming the halls during class time. They are to either be in class or under the direct supervision of the parent. If there are children waiting for a parent, have them sit with you.
- Remind children, when necessary, to walk, not run, in the halls and to respect church property.
- Absolutely no children in the halls, with or without parents during class time. Please have parents take advantage of our "Mom's Room" during class time.
- Assist the teachers of younger children by helping them with bathroom breaks.
- Playground for preschool use only. Make sure all toys are returned to patio when done.
- No children are allowed outside the doors between classes. Watch the younger children especially carefully.
- Curtain on stage should be closed at all times. Make sure it covers the speakers at front of stage.
- Stage off limits!
- Toys/games in all rooms off limits!
- No Personal Electronic Devices are allowed at co-op.
- Closets in gym off limits! Exception: When setting/cleaning up tables and chairs.
- Enter through gym to go upstairs. A/V room off limits! Students may not go upstairs unless they have a class there.
- Teenagers who drive may not sit in cars in parking lot during lunch or class times. They must remain in the building.
